## Introduction:

After many years 'off-limits' to birders, Colombia has finally become accessible again – and safely so. For several decades it has appeared in the media all too frequently as the location for stories about drugs barons, kidnappings and the activities of the notorious FARC guerrillas. Now finally a democratic government is firmly in charge once again bringing long-awaited stability to the country, and an excellent bird conservation organisation – ProAves – has established a whole string of reserves, many with purpose built lodges that can accommodate small groups of birdwatchers. Thus our small group explored what is perhaps the most exciting country in South America at present, given its poorly-known avifauna and seldom-visited national parks and reserves.

We had been warned in the tour description that this would be a fairly demanding tour – and indeed it was. Colombia is a very big country and as described there were lots of long drives, many on fairly narrow mountainous roads through the Andes. And there were lots of hikes, some fairly long and many up-hill, again due to the Andes. In places the accommodation was fairly basic and we had to get used to cold showers. But the food was good throughout and the people we met were without exception very friendly and helpful. The scenery was outstanding, especially in the High Andes and we visited lots of beautiful and varied habitats. And, of course, the birds were spectacular.

In three weeks we recorded around 550 species and these included about 50 birds endemic to Colombia. Highlights were numerous and are detailed in the following list, but amongst the many birds-of-the-trip the following stand out; the bizarre Northern Screamers, the once thought-to-be-extinct Cauca Guan, the Bogota Rail that played hide-and-seek with us for an hour or more before finally showing itself well, the Noble Snipe displaying low overhead for a similar period of time, the endangered Yellow-eared Parrots a pair of which flew in from the far distance and landed in the very bush next to which we were standing, the Colombian Screech-Owl which showed itself so well, the tame day-roosting Stygian Owl found for us by the warden at the Piha reserve, the many fantastic hummingbirds including such spectacular species as Black Inca and White-tailed Starfrontlet, the White-mantled Barbet that was so fascinated with us, the gorgeous Black-billed Mountain-Toucan that came in silently, the lovely pair of Chestnut Piculets in the semi-desert scrub, the secretive Recurve-billed Bushbird in its bamboo home, the worm-eating Santa Marta Antpitta, the recently discovered Chestnut-capped Piha, the remarkably obliging Apolinar's Wren and Munchique Wood-Wren, the intriguing Turquoise Dacnis, the long-sought-after Tanager Finches, and the beautiful Red-bellied Grackles - just a few of the many superb birds that we experienced on this tour.

## Taxonomic treatment:

The names used in this list mostly follow those in *Birds of the World: Recommended English Names* by F. Gill and M. 1. The New World forms of Moorhen have just been split from the Old World forms and this has been accepted by SACC. They call the New World bird Common Gallinule *Gallinula galeata*.
2. The New World forms of Sandwich Tern have just been split from the Old World forms. The New World forms (which include Cayenne Tern) are now called Cabot's Tern *Thalasseus aculflavidus*.

3. Blue-crowned Motmot has just been split into five species, four of which occur in South America. This has been accepted by SACC and is likely to be accepted for the world lists shortly. The form that we saw in lowland Colombia is now called Whooping Motmot *Momotus subrufescens*. One of the other forms is what we had been calling Highland Motmot *Motmotus aequatorialis*, which is now being called Andean Motmot by SACC.

4. Paramo Tapaculo *Scytalopus canus* has just been split into two species Paramillo Tapaculo *Scytalopus canus* and Paramo Tapaculo *Scytalopus opacus*. We saw Paramillo Tapaculo on the tour.
