Itinerary

14 August: Visit to the Villa Marshes and coastal lagoons and beach. Later we visited San Pedro Fields at Km 31 of the Pan Am Highway south. Continuing south we stopped at a patch of *Prosopis* bushes at kilometer 258. We finished the day looking at birds in the garden of the Hotel Mirador in Paracas.

15 August : We started birding at the El Chaco pier before boarding the boat to the Ballestas Islands. Later we visited the lookout area near the museum and El Sequion beach, Lagunillos and la Playa la Mina before returning to Lima

16 de Agosto: We went directly to the Autisha bridge area in the Santa Eulalia Valley. After that we returned to Lima birding along the way stopping at small riverside willow thicket along the way.

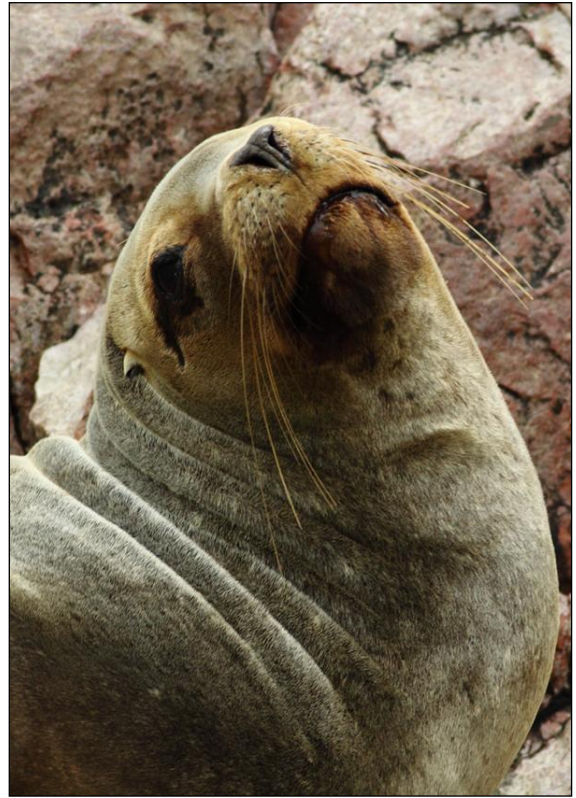
